

Information for a New Association President

This is a list of items that you need to be aware of:

- The Vancouver Mainland Football League (VMFL) is a not profit association made up of member associations.
- All member association must be a registered Society and be a member of the British Columbia Community Football Association (BCCFA).
- A copy of your Letter of Good Standing must be submitted to the VMFL secretary.
- The VMFL is governed by the BC Societies Act, the VMFL Constitution and the VMFL Handbook.
- VMFL Fees are \$10 / player based on the previous years rosters. These fees are due by July 1 of the current year. This amount may be changed by the VMFL Executive based on yearly budgets.
- BCCFA fees are \$3 / player
- The VMFL will invoice associations for VMFL and BCCFA fees. These are based on your previous years frozen rosters.
- The VMFL meets as a group as a rule on the 1st Wednesday of assigned months and in late August for the Schedule.
- August 1 is the deadline to commit teams for the upcoming schedule.
- The VMFL requires players to be verified on a roster form by another association president or a member of the VMFL Executive. Players must be verified before being eligible to play in a VMFL League game.
- The Roster forms are included in the VMFL Handbook and are available on the VMFL website www.vmfl.ca.
- After the 5th week of the VMFL Schedule, the rosters are frozen and you are not allowed to add or delete players.
- Your Football BC (FBC) fees are due October 31 based on current year registration. The FBC fee is \$10 per player, Cheerleader and volunteers. There is also an amount due for Insurance. This amount will change from year to year. Football BC or the BCCFA will let you know the amount.
- Football BC will issue an insurance certificate to your association and your municipality. Insurance runs from July 1st to June 30th.
- The VMFL supports the Make A Wish charity by donating .20 cents / offensive point scored. Due to financial hardship this is not mandatory.
